Honor God and Love People into a Growing Relationship with Jesus Christ

(Prayer prompts form the study of James)

HONOR GOD

Praise, Adoration, and Thanksgiving to God

- o God is good, in Him there is no evil or even the possibility of evil
- He generously gives wisdom
- He is the Creator
- o God does not change, He can always be trusted
- Every good and perfect gift comes from God
- He is the final Judge
- God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble
- He gives us more grace
- The Lord is full of compassion and mercy

Repentance and Confession of Sin

- o Get rid of all moral filth that is so prevalent
- Humbly accept God's Word as true
- o Come near to God and He will come near to you
- Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. Grieve, mourn and wail. Change your laughter to mourning and your joy to gloom. Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.

Obey God

- o In crisis we turn to Him as the only One who can save
- We turn away from false saviors
- We humbly accept God's Word as true
- Don't merely listen to God's Word, do what it says
- Out of the same mouth comes praise for God and cursing of our neighbor, this should not be
- Get rid of bitter envy, selfish ambition
- Submit yourself to God,
- o Don't be arrogant; commit your plans to the Lord; we should say, "if it is the Lord's will..."
- Be patient and stand firm

Ask God, by the power of the Holy Spirit, to cause us to obey

Believers (and the church) must keep themselves from being polluted by the sinful ways of the world

LOVE PEOPLE

- Encourage other believers to Honor God
- o Pray for other believers and confront the sin that we recognize in their lives
- You must not show favoritism
- Be quick to listen, slow to speak, slow to become angry
- Keep a tight rein on your tongue
- Pray against evil and sin (that is in our church, community, our nation, our world); the greatest evil is the rejection of God as Savior and Lord
- Be moved with compassion for those who are rejecting God and his truth
- o Care for widows and orphans in distress, give of ourselves for the least of these
- Love your neighbor (to Christ) as you love yourself to love yourself appropriately is to love God primarily
- Treat others with mercy, for God is the Judge
- o Out of the same mouth comes praise for God and cursing of our neighbor, this should not be
- o Be peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy, impartial, sincere
- Be a peacemaker
- Do not slander one another
- Do not take advantage of the poor, the weak, the powerless
- Don't grumble against one another
- o Be one who tells the truth

Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

My brothers and sisters, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring that person back, remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of their way will save them from death and cover over a multitude of sins.
