

# Parable: THE Good Samaritan




God's Law says: 'Love your neighbour as yourself.'

A man was walking along the road from Jerusalem to the town of Jericho when some bad men ran off with his coat and left him lying on the side of the road, badly hurt.




The hurt man lay in the hot sun.


